"By integrating key learning principles into the science of reading, words take flight as students experience thousands of exposures in targeted practice," she continued. "Ultimately, and most importantly, students take flight as they access the power of written language and the joy of reading. We are very excited about our new name, *WordFlight*, which perfectly connotes how the solution works and helps students."

WordFlight is designed for both developing and struggling readers in grades 2 and above who:

- are developing foundational reading skills;
- struggle with comprehension and fluency;
- read slowly, with great effort and difficulty;
- struggle with decoding;
- cannot quickly and automatically apply phonics knowledge to new words or to connected text.

Dr. Brown said *WordFlight* also is very effective and efficient for English Language Learners, as well as students with special learning needs (dyslexia, special education) — who are among the populations that lag in reading proficiency measures, according to the most recent Nation's Report Card.

A Texas-based educator praises *WordFlight* for its ability to help students build automatic word recognition faster and feel successful as they learn.
